Campers will act and speak positively to all campers and staff.

Campers will respect the people and places they come in contact with.

Campers will set a positive example and act as a role model for others.

Campers must agree to accept their share of daily assigned activities and responsibilities.

Campers will treat everyone in the camp community with respect at all times.

This includes:

- respect for the belongings of others,
- responsibility for personal belongings,
- respect for camp facilities and equipment,
- respect for the feelings and privacy of others.

The following behaviors are considered very serious and will result in the loss of certain camp privileges, a phone call to the parent/guardian, and/or expulsion from camp:

- threatening to harm self or others,
- verbal abuse of another camper or staff,
- the use of obscene language or gestures,
- physical abuse of any kind including the hitting, kicking, biting, pulling hair, etc. of another camper or staff member,
- behavior that is constantly interfering with the quality of program other campers are receiving.
