Rules of the Camp:

4. Each camper will be responsible for maintaining personal and camp cleanliness.
5. Each camper will be responsible for any damages and loss.
6. Illness and injury must be reported immediately to camp nurse or director.
7. No campers are allowed to transport themselves to and from camp.
8. Campers will remain on the camp property at all times during the session, except when on field trips escorted by the staff.
9. Campers are expected to abide by the camper contract, dress code, and camp rules, including those of Rancho del Chaparral, and respect the authority of the directors. Violators will be removed from camp and sent home at their own expense.
